

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

## Programme Managers to Support Implementation of Jamaica Water Supply and Sewerage Projects

National Water Commission (NWC) intends to develop and implement major water supply and sewerage system projects across the country over the next five years. It is expected to spend approximately US\$600 Million on these works island-wide primarily aimed at:

- (a) Reducing Non-Revenue Water (NRW) and energy cost and improving water transmission and distribution systems;
- (b) Improving and expanding potable water production facilities;
- (c) Rehabilitating and expanding sewage collection, treatment and disposal systems.

NWC has prepared its Water Supply Parish Plans and Sewerage Services Parish Plans, which provide the framework for the development of the Capital Programme. Projects will be selected from these plans based on net benefit.

NWC is seeking the services of qualified firms to provide Programme Management Services to support the implementation of priority water supply and sewerage projects based on these Parish Plans.

Qualified Consultants are invited to submit technical and financial proposals to provide Programme Management services based on the Request for Proposal (RFP). Interested firms should download the RFP document from the NWC's website at
