## **Port Antonio Water, Sewerage & Drainage Project**

### ***Contract for the Installation and Commissioning into Service of Electromagnetic and Mechanical Flow Meters and Ancillary Equipment***

The National Water Commission (NWC), through its Engineering Department intends to continue the implementation works on the Port Antonio Water Sewerage & Drainage Project. The project area constitutes the central and immediate surrounding areas of the town of Port Antonio, Portland on the north-east coast of Jamaica.

The NWC hereby invites tenders from suitable contracting entities currently registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at Grade 2 minimum in the categories of Civil Engineering/Pipe Laying/Instrumentation for the installation of Electromagnetic and Mechanical Flow Meters and Ancillary Equipment.

The Contract provides for the detailed design of facilities (based on Specifications and typical details) to ensure the protection and correct functionality of Electromagnetic and Mechanical Flow meters and Ancillary Equipment plus the installation of the Electromagnetic and Mechanical Flow meters and Ancillary Equipment within the area surrounding Port Antonio. The extent of the contracting services is the associated design and installation of:

- **11 no. Electromagnetic Flow meters from 100mm up to 300mm diameter**
- **12 no. Mechanical Flow meters from 50mm up to 250mm diameter**
- **23 no. Pressure Tappings**
- **23 no. Secure Equipment Enclosures containing Data Logger, pressure Transducer and Cellular Communication Outstation**
- **1 no. Central Receiving Station and complete Cellular Data Link**

Prospective tenderers may obtain documents as of **Monday, July 14, 2008 between 9:30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m.** each weekday at the Capital Projects Unit, 4 Marescaux Road, Kingston 5, (tel: 511 – 5456/7). Documents will be available at a **non-refundable cost of JA\$ 3000 each.** Payment will be accepted only in cash or manager's cheque at the Commission's Commercial Department.

Tenderers must submit a copy of their current Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and Certificate of Registration from the National Contracts Commission (NCC) along with all bids. The original of both Certificates must be presented at the opening of the tender or within two (2) working days of the opening thereof.

Tenders must be placed in a plain envelope (as outlined in the Instructions to Tenderers), which is sealed and appropriately marked on the outside of the envelope:

All tenders submitted will then be opened on **Thursday August 28, 2008** in the First Floor Conference Room at 11:30 a.m. in the presence of tenders/representatives who choose to attend.
