The National Water Commission (NWC) has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the **Kingston Water and Sanitation Project**. It is intended that part of the financing proceeds be applied to eligible payments under the contract for which this invitation for bids is issued.

The NWC is establishing a hot site for Disaster Recovery Planning (DRP) purposes. The site will be hosting hardware and software for the support of the recently implemented Customer Information System (CIS).

NWC invites sealed bids from eligible bidders from the IDB Member Countries for the supply Oracle RDMS licenses for the Disaster Recovery Planning (DRP) site. Local entities are required to be currently registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) as suppliers of goods and services to the Government of Jamaica and possess valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). Sealed bids are to be submitted containing the Technical and Financial proposals related to this procurement.

A set of bidding documents may be purchased by interested bidders Mondays to Fridays **starting Monday, January 18, 2010 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** at the address below. This will be for a **non-refundable fee of JA\$10,000, or US\$115.00**, payable to the National Water Commission either in cash or by bank-guaranteed cheque.
