The National Water Commission invites Expressions of Interest for Debt Collections Services island-wide from suitably qualified persons and companies. These services will be required in the Eastern and Western divisions. The Eastern Division consists of the parishes of Clarendon, Portland, St Mary, St Catherine, Kingston, St Andrew and St Thomas. The Western Division consists of the parishes of Manchester, St Elizabeth, Westmoreland, Hanover, St James, Trelawny and St Ann.

Expressions of interest to provide these services, on an as required basis, are being invited from persons or companies who are registered with the National Contracts Commission to perform the required services and in possession of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). They should have proven track record as debt collectors, possess adequate and trained staff to carry out the services and be willing to enter into a specified period contract on terms set out by the NWC and to accept performance based remuneration.
