

INVITATION TO TENDER

THE PERMANENT REINSTATEMENT OF THE ROADWAY ALONG STANDPIPE LANE

The National Water Commission (NWC), through its Engineering and Project Delivery Department, intends to reinstate the roadway along Standpipe Lane which was disturbed during the laying of a sewer to expand the collection network.

The NWC in this instance invites Contractors who are duly registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the categories of Road Maintenance Works and or General Road Works, Grade 3 minimum, to tender for works to be implemented herein.

The works will include the permanent reinstatement of some 330 metres of roadway along Standpipe Lane, from its intersection with Cedar Valley Terrace to the vicinity of the Barbican Gully with asphaltic concrete all in accordance with Contract Specifications and Conditions; in particular being able to effect the works to the satisfaction of the relevant road and safety authorities.

Prospective Tenderers may obtain documents as of **Thursday, September 29, 2011** between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. each weekday at the Engineering and Project Delivery Department, 4 Marescaux Road, Kingston 5 (Tel: 733-5456/7 Fax: 929-3642, e-mail chief.engineer@nwc.com.jm).

Tenderers must submit a copy of their current Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), valid Certificate of Registration from the National Contracts Commission (NCC) and requisite Bid Bond along with their bid. **The original of both Certificates must be presented at the opening of tender or within three (3) working days of said opening.**

A pre-tender site visit is scheduled for Thursday, October 6, 2011, 10:00 a.m. at the NWC's Widcombe Sewage Treatment Plant, 33 Barbican Terrace, Kingston 8 and it is advisable that all interested participants be present.

Tenders must be returned in a plain envelope (as outlined in the Instructions to Tenderers), which is sealed and appropriately marked on the outside of the envelope:

“Permanent Reinstatement of Standpipe Lane Roadway”.

All tenders submitted will then be opened on Thursday, **October 13, 2011** at the 1st Floor Conference Room, 18 Oxford Road, Kingston 5 commencing at 11:15 am in the presence of tenderers/representatives who choose to attend.

The National Water Commission is not obliged to accept the lowest or any tender. Additionally, prior to any award a prospective contractor will be required to demonstrate to the NWC that they possess the necessary staff and equipment coupled with satisfactory experience to satisfy the requirement for specified trench reinstatement, approved traffic control and works safety while working in public roadways.
