Interested individuals/entities must have particular knowledge of the policies and/or business systems of the Commission and/or of its existing water supply, sewage treatment and/or sewerage facilities. Specialist advice and assistance to the Commission is required for assignments which are either time critical or require particular specialist knowledge or expertise in any of the following areas:

- Public / Private partnerships in the Water and Wastewater Sectors
- Non-Revenue-Water (NRW) Initiatives
- Tariff Studies / Preparation of Applications for Tariff Revisions
