MAY PEN WATER SUPPLY, CLARENDON REHABILITATION & UPGRADING PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION OF THE WOODSIDE WELL TO GUINEP TREE 300 mm NOMINAL DIAMETER TRANSMISSION PIPELINE

The National Water Commission, through its Engineering Department, intends to continue the islandwide rehabilitation and upgrading works on its potable domestic water supply systems to benefit our valued customer base and aid developments being contemplated. In this instance the NWC will be implementing works in the May Pen Supply area including the communities of Woodside, Four Paths, Jacob's Hut, Denbigh, Treadlight and environs in Clarendon.

The NWC hereby invites tenders from suitable contracting entities currently registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at Grade 2 minimum, in the categories of Pipelaying and or Civil Engineering, for the complete construction of approximately 5.5 kilometres of 300 mm (12") nominal diameter PVC pipeline of stated specification and quality together with numerous appurtenances; extending from the Woodside Well site to the Chapelton Road/Main Street intersection at Guinep Tree via the Woodside Main Road, Muirhead and Manchester Avenues.

Prospective Tenderers may obtain Documents as of **Monday, September 22, 2008 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.** each weekday at the Engineering Department, 4 Marescaux Road, Kingston 5 (Tel: 511-5456/7 Fax: 929-3642). Documents will be available at a **non-refundable cost of J\$3,000.00 each.** Payment will be accepted in cash or manager's cheque only, at the Collection Department.

Tenderers must submit a copy of their current Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and current Certificate of Registration from the National Contracts Commission (NCC) along with their tender. **The original of both Certificates must be presented at the opening of tender or within five (5) working days of the opening thereof.**
