

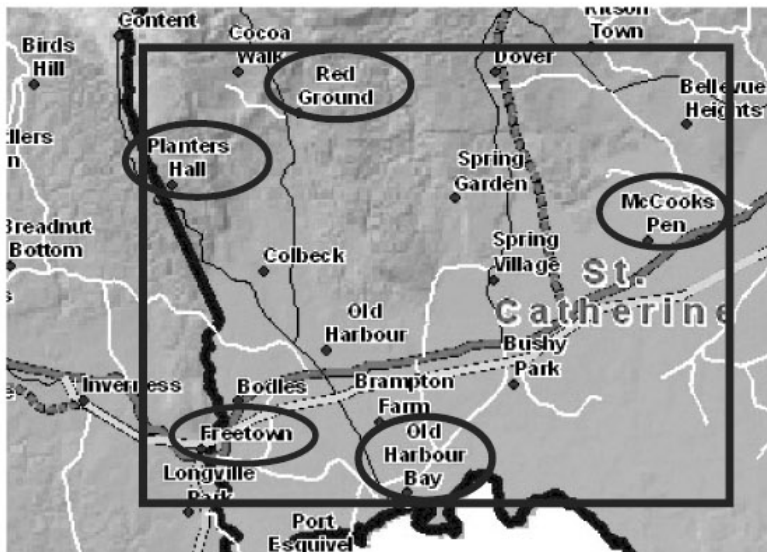
Public Invitation

To Prospective Land Developers To Express Interest of Development Plans

Network Master Plan of Potable Water Resources -
Old Harbour Area, St. Catherine.

The National Water Commission (NWC) through its Engineering and Corporate & Strategic Planning Departments (and working in close collaboration with the Water Resources Authority, WRA), intends to implement, at earliest, a Network Master Plan of the potable water resources it owns and operates in the Old Harbour Water Distribution Area of St. Catherine bounded by:

- Freetown on the Clarendon/St. Catherine border to the West,
- Red Ground/Planters Hall to the North,
- McCooks Pen to the East,
- Old Harbour Bay and the sea to the South



In order to ascertain that the NWC will be able to adequately satisfy the projected demand for potable water in the Area, the Commission hereby invites **all prospective housing developers and other land development agencies to make immediate** contact with the:
