

# Request For Proposals (RFP)

## **DE LA VEGA CITY SANITARY SEWER, TWICKENHAM PARK ST. CATHERINE**

### **THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT (DESIGN – BUILD) OF THE PIPE BRIDGE SPANNING THE RIO COBRE RIVER AT THE FIDCo. STABILISATION PONDS**

The National Water Commission, through its Engineering Department, invites entities who are currently registered with the National Contracts Commission in the categories of Bridge Construction/Civil Engineering, Grades 1 and 2, to submit proposals for works to be implemented in the St. Catherine Sewerage District at the Rio Cobre influent pipe crossing at the FIDCo. Stabilisation Ponds at Twickenham Park.

The works will include the design, supply of materials, and installation/construction complete, of approximately 60 metres of pipe support and fixing of 150 mm (6") nominal diameter sewer together with scouring/erosion protection and other rehabilitative works.

Prospective proposers may obtain RFP documents as of **Monday, March 9, 2009** between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. each weekday at the Engineering Department, 4 Marescaux Road, Kingston 5 (Tel: 511-5456/7 Fax: 929-3642). Documents will be available at a non-refundable cost of J\$3,000.00 each. Payment will be accepted in cash or manager's cheque only, (at the Commercial/Collection Department).

Proposers must submit a copy of their current Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), Certificate of Registration from the National Contracts Commission (NCC) along with their tender and Bid Bond if required.

***The original of both Certificates must be presented at the opening of responses or within five (5) working days of the opening thereof.***
