

INVITATION TO TENDER

SEWERAGE OF SEYMOUR LANDS/TRAFALGAR PARK/NEW KINGSTONST. ANDREW

THE CONSTRUCTION OF LADY MUSGRAVE ROAD/ UPPER MUSGRAVE/MUSGRAVE AVENUES/ARGYLE ROAD COLLECTOR SEWERS

The National Water Commission, through its Engineering Department, invites contractors who are currently registered on the National Contracts Commission Register of Public Sector Contractors in the categories of Pipelaying/Civil Engineering, Grades 1 and 2, to tender for works to be implemented in the KSA Sewerage District on Lady Musgrave Road/Upper Musgrave/Argyle Road/Musgrave Avenue, running from the intersection at Hopefield Avenue to Trafalgar Road. Inclusive of an approximate 0.3 km section along Lady Musgrave Road from its intersection at Argyle Road/Fairway Avenue to the traffic lights at Trafalgar Road.

The works will include the complete construction of approximately 740 metres of 250 mm (10")/300 meters of 400 mm (16") nominal diameter sewer pipes of stated specification and quality together with numerous sewer manholes and plot/road laterals.

Prospective tenderers may obtain documents as of Monday, October 2, 2006 between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. each weekday at the Engineering Department, 4 Marescaux Road, Kingston 5 (Tel: 511-5456/7 Fax: 929-3642). Documents will be available at a non-refundable cost of J\$3,000.00 each. Payments will be accepted in cash or manager's cheque only, (at the Commercial Office).

Tenderers must submit a copy of their current Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and Certificate of Registration from the National Contracts Commission (NCC) along with their tender. The original of both Certificates must be presented at the opening of tender or within five (5) working days of the opening thereof.
