Pipeline Improvement Work in Spanish Town, St. Catherine

Beginning October 8, 2007, the National Water Commission (NWC) will begin the replacement of old pipelines in sections of Spanish Town in St. Catherine as part of the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) Water Supply Project.

These works will be carried out between **October 2007** and **April 2008**. The pipeline replacement project will result in intermittent disruption in the regular water supply, traffic changes, and possible noise and dust nuisance for customers in Spanish Town. Timely notice will be issued to advise the public of the time and extent of the phased interruptions of water supply and any traffic changes that may become necessary.

The NWC is therefore advising customers to make the necessary arrangements to store water for use during this period of upgrading work.

Already, pipeline replacement works have been carried out and are almost complete for sections of Willowdene and Hopedale in St. Catherine. The mains replacement work for Spanish Town will begin with **Monk Street, Barrett Street, Rivoli Avenue, Adelaide Street and King Street during October, and will move on to other streets during the six-month mains replacement project period.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience that may be experienced by our valued customers during the period of these upgrading works.
