The National Water Commission wishes to inform customers who are served by the **York Town Relift Station in Clarendon** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is caused by electrical problems at the facility.

Customers may therefore experience low water pressure or no water conditions until the necessary repairs are completed on the system.

In the meantime areas affected by this disruption include; **York Town, Howells, Content, Bullards Content, Hopewell, Parnassus, Denbigh Drive, Foga Road and Four Paths Settlement.**

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience caused and is working to restore service by tomorrow, October 9.
