At present some thirteen (13) systems are out of service. These include;

- New Town Well
- Twin Palms Well
- Sheckles Well
- Goshen Well
- York Town Well
- Clarendon Park Well
- Toll Gate Well
- Belle Plain Well
- Rhymesbury Deep Well
- Curatoe Hill Well
- New Bowens Well
- Mineral Heights Well

The National Water Commission wishes to advise however that the JPSCo is already working to resolve these problems so operations can resume at the earliest possible time.
