**Maintenance & repair works to Cause water supply disruption
.....Sections of St. Catherine & St. Thomas to be affected**

The National Water Commission will be carrying out maintenance works on the Jericho Pumping Station in St. Catherine on Tuesday, December 1, 2009 at approximately 10:00am. The scheduled works will require that the facility be shut down until Wednesday, December 2, 2009. Customers served by this facility will therefore experience low water pressure or no water conditions for the period.

Areas to be affected include; White House, Banbury, Victoria, Orangefield, Jericho, Polly Ground, sections of Linstead and Charlemont Housing Scheme.

In the meantime, the Bachelors Hall Pumping Station in St. Thomas will be temporarily shut down on Tuesday, December 1, 2009 between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm. This is to facilitate urgent repairs to a valve at the facility. Customers will therefore experience a disruption in their water supply.

Areas that will be affected include; Amity Hall, Quaw Hill, Dalvey, Top House, Duckensfield, Stokes Hall, Golden Grove, Port Morant, Chovey, Harbour Head, Style Hut, Land Top and Hill Sixty.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience caused by these necessary works and will endeavor to restore service in the times indicated.
