Mechanical Problem causes Water Supply Disruption to sections of St. Andrew

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers served by the West Kirkland Heights Pumping Station and the Forest Hills Relift Station in St. Andrew that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is as a result of a mechanical problem on the West Kirkland Heights system.

Areas affected include, **Pine View, East Kirkland Heights, Red Hills, Brentwood, Pleasant Valley, Plantation Heights, Belvedere, Woodland Circle, Rock Pond, Sterling Castle, Mosquito Valley, Leas Flat and Forrest Hills.**

It is not anticipated that the system will be fully restored before Wednesday, of this week. Water will be trucked to the affected areas.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience caused by this disruption and is working to ensure full restoration of service at the soonest possible time.
