POWER SUPPLY PROBLEMS CONTINUE TO AFFECT NWC SYSTEMS

The National Water Commission is advising customers in some sections of Kingston, St. Catherine and St. Thomas that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is as a result of low voltage problems at a number of its facilities in these parishes.

In St. Catherine, the Tulloch Springs, Goldmine and Cocoa Ridge Water Supply Systems are without adequate power supply. This has affected water supply to customers in the corporate area, specifically along **Washington Boulevard** and all roads leading off, **Molynes Road** and all roads leading off, **Spanish Town Road** and all roads leading off, while in St. Catherine sections of **Portmore, Bodose Hill, Bellas Gate, Cocoa Ridge, Sand Hole, Rhule Town, Planters, Sandy Ground, Bellfield, Marlie Hill, Joe Ground, Bamboo Ridge, Bartons, Wood Hall, Browns Hall, Blue Hole, and Macca Tree** are without service.

In the meantime, the **Apple Farm Well, Spring Gardens and Needham Pen/Ward River Relift Stations in St. Thomas** are also out of service due to limited power supply.

Areas served by these systems include; **Springfield, Barking Lodge, New Pera, Hill Top, Chapel Hill, Cricket Hill, Ginger Piece, Pear Tree River, Batchelor's Hall, Apple Farm and environs, Dalvey, Duckenfield, Hampton Court, Cheswick, Brownman Hill, Braeton Hill, Hill Sixty, Rocky Point, Winchester, Stokes Hall, Golden Grove, Bowden, Ward River, Needham Pen and environs, Phillips Avenue, Top Hill Road, Pipe Road, Spring Garden, Middleton, Stony Gut and Stanton.**

The National Water Commission is reminding customers that power supply becomes particularly unstable in high windy conditions and this in turn will affect operations at its facilities.

The National Water Commission is working with the Jamaica Public Service Company to resolve these problems at the soonest possible time and apologizes for any inconvenience caused to its valued customers.
