TRUCKING SCHEDULE IMPLEMENTED FOR WESTERN KINGSTON & ST. ANDREW AREAS

In an effort to meet the current challenges caused by the ongoing dry season, the National Water Commission is advising that it has implemented a trucked water schedule for some of the severely affected communities in western Kingston & St. Andrew.

With immediate effect, these communities will receive trucked water as follows;

DAY	COMMUNITIES
Monday	Sherbourne Heights, Sherbourne Avenue, Sherbourne Drive and Sherbourne Close
Tuesday	Baden Powell Road, Armour Close, Sherbourne Park
Wednesday	Diamond Road, Wireless Station Road, Wireless Drive, Wireless Place
Thursday	Kingswood Road, Kingswood Tank, Wedmore Rise, Christopher Drive
Friday	Mount Friendship, Mount James, Iron River, Lawrence Tavern, Unity, Fern Hill
Saturday	Woodland Circle, Cypruss Hall, Belvedere, Mount Atlas Peak, Waugh Hill, Kerr Hill and Topper Hill

All previously communicated restriction arrangements will remain in place.

The National Water Commission continues to appeal for the understanding and cooperation of its customers as it seeks to implement the necessary measures to alleviate no water conditions caused by the extensive dry period.
