Water Supply Disruption sections of St. Thomas & St. Mary

National Water Commission customers in **St. Thomas** who are served by the **East Albion Well** will experience low water pressure or no water conditions tomorrow, **March 30, 2010** between the hours of **8:00am and 5:00pm**. This is as the facility will be taken out of operation for maintenance works.

Areas that will be affected by this disruption include,

Albion
Easington
Yallahs Housing Scheme
Yallahs Industries
Poorman's Corner and Red Hills

Customers are therefore being urged to store water for use during the period of service interruption.

In the meantime, customers in **Gibraltar Heights in St. Mary** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to a mechanical problem at the **Gibraltar Relift Station**. The system has been taken out of operation for repair works and it is anticipated that restoration will take place by **April 6, 2010**. Arrangements have therefore been made to supply trucked water to customers.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
