Maintenance Repairs Scheduled for St. Catherine Water Supply Systems

The National Water Commission is advising that its Central Village Well, the Nutshell and Ewarton Relift Stations located in St. Catherine will be taken out of operation tomorrow, June 3, 2010, between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm for maintenance repairs.

Customers in a number of areas will experience no water conditions or low water pressure and are therefore being urged to store water for use during the specified hours.
