WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST. CATHERINE

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in sections of Spanish Town who are served by the Spanish Town Treatment Plant that they will experience low water pressure or no water conditions tomorrow, June 2, 2010 between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.

This disruption in service comes as the National Water Commission continues upgrading works on some of its facilities in St. Catherine under the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) water supply improvement project.

Areas that will be affected include;

Spanish Town, Westmore, Hampton Green, Lakemore Gardens, Newton Avenue, Nugent Street, McCoy's Land, Mayfair Mews, Brunswick Avenue, Job's Lane, White Water Meadows, Hartlands, McCooks Pen, Leiba Gardens, Sydenham Gardens, Wedge Wood Gdns, Willowdene Housing Scheme, and Hopedale Housing Scheme.

Customers in these areas are therefore being asked to store water for use until normalcy returns.

In the meantime, customers in sections of St. Catherine, specifically **Angel Estate # 1 & 2, Angels Grove, Dam Head, Angels Vista, and Angels Arcadia** are being advised that the recent interruptions in their water supply is due to challenges being experienced at the Angels #1 Well and the ongoing checks being carried out on the distribution network. The National Water Commission is assuring that every effort is being made to resolve the problems and will supply trucked water until regular service is restored.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused in these instances.
