SCHEDULED SHUTDOWN OF SPANISH TOWN TREATMENT PLANT

On Wednesday, June 9, 2010, the National Water Commission will be temporarily shutting down operations at the Spanish Town Treatment Plant to facilitate the installation of a lift pump. This work forms part of the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) project and will be conducted between the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm.

Areas served by the Treatment Plant will therefore experience a disruption in their water supply during these hours. These areas include:
