### **Water Supply Disruption in sections of Portland**

The National Water Commission is reporting that the **Windsor Castle Treatment Plant and Drapers Relift Station located in Portland** are currently out of operation due to mechanical problems at these facilities. This has resulted in no water conditions and low water pressure for a number of customers in the parish.

Areas affected by these downtimes include:

**Windsor Forrest  
Commodore  
Hartford  
sections of Black Rock  
sections of Long Bay  
sections of Fair Prospect  
Martha Brae Road  
Drapers  
Drapers Heights and San San.**

Every effort is being made to resolve these issues so that operations can be resumed at both facilities by Wednesday, June 9.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers and will endeavour to restore normalcy at the soonest possible time.
