**SINGLE PHASE POWER PROBLEMS CAUSE WATER SUPPLY
DISRUPTION...SECTIONS OF CORPORATE AREA AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that the **Chancery Hall Water Supply System** in St. Andrew is currently out of service due to power supply problems. This has resulted in no water conditions and low water pressure for some customers served by the system.

Presently, the National Water Commission is working with the power supply company to resolve the problem and resume operations within the shortest possible time.

Areas that may be affected by this disruption include; **Lady Hamilton Drive, Van Guard, sections of Michigan Avenue, Lord Nelson Drive, sections of Lady Hamilton Drive, Horatio Drive, Flagstaff, To-Gallant Close, Quarter Deck, and sections of East Kirkland Heights.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers and is working to ensure the restoration of service as soon as possible.
