### **BROKEN MAIN AFFECTS WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW**

The National Water Commission is advising that there is a broken 21” main on the Seaview Water Supply System that has caused temporary shutdown of the Seaview Filter Plant and reduced inflows to the Constant Spring Treatment Plant.

Customers served by these facilities will therefore experience low water pressure and in some instances no water conditions. Areas affected include:

**Stony Hill, Golden Spring, Jack's Hill, Stillwell Road, Lawrence Tavern, Tavistock, Mannings Hill Road, Bridge Mount, Sunset Avenue, Boone Hall, Mt. Ogle, Constant Spring, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Half-Way-Tree, Lady Musgrave, sections of Liguanea, Manor Park, Shortwood, Graham Heights, Aylsham, Allergyce, Acadia, White Hall Gardens, Belgrade, Kingswood, Riva Ridge, Eastwood Park Gardens, Hughenden, Barbican Road, Russell Heights Constant Spring Road & Gardens, Camperdown, Red Hills Road, Arlene Gardens, Roehampton, Smokey Vale, Club, Chancery Hall Heights, Tavistock, Trench Town, Essex Hall, Cavaliers, Calabar Mews, Zaidie Gardens and State Gardens.**

The National Water Commission is currently conducting the necessary repairs and is making every effort to restore normal service in the soonest possible time.
