**POWER SUPPLY PROBLEMS & BROKEN MAIN CAUSE WATER SUPPLY  
DISRUPTION...SECTIONS OF KINGSTON & ST. ANDREW AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is reporting that there is a break on a 21" distribution main in the vicinity of Spanish Town Road which has caused temporary locking of the line in order to carry out the necessary repairs.

Customers will therefore experience no water conditions and in some instances no water conditions until the completion of repairs. Areas affected include:

**Spanish Town Road and all roads leading off  
Sections of Molyne's Road and  
Sections of Washington Gardens.**

In the meantime, customers served by the **Castle James Relift Station** and **Barnett Wood Water Supply system in St. Andrew** are currently experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to power problems at these facilities. Communities that may be affected include:

Woodland Circle  
Cul de Sac  
Swain Spring  
Burnt Side Valley  
Castle James  
Shoucair Circle  
Padmore  
Sections of Sterling Castle  
Cavaliers  
Pinto**
