## **Service Disruption for sections of St. Catherine**

The National Water Commission is advising that the **Golden Acres Pumping Station** in St. Catherine is currently out of operation in order to facilitate urgent repairs on the pumping unit. This **closure will continue until Tuesday, July 20, 2010.**

Customers served by this facility will therefore experience no water conditions until restoration of the system. Areas affected include:

**Golden Acres**  
**Strathmore Gardens**  
**G.C. Foster College**  
**Avon Park**  
**Villmore Gardens**

Trucked water will be supplied to customers as the National Water Commission makes every attempt to minimize the effects of the disruption.

In the meantime, the **Spanish Town Treatment Plant** will be shut down on **Wednesday, July 21, 2010, between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.** This necessary closure is to facilitate replacement of power cables as works continue under the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) Project.

Areas supplied by the Spanish Town Treatment Plant will therefore experience a disruption in water supply and are being urged to store water for use during the specified hours. These areas include:
