National Water Commission customers who are served by the **Mona Filter Plant in St. Andrew** are being advised that they will experience low water pressure as of **Tuesday, January 25, 2011 continuing into the second week of February. This is due to extensive maintenance works that will be carried out at the facility.**

Customers served by the **Forrest Hills system** are also being advised that on **Wednesday, January 26, 2010, maintenance works will be carried out on the system between the hours of 4:00am and 2:00pm.** This will result in no water conditions. Customers are therefore being urged to store water for use during the period of disruption. Areas that will be affected include: **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle, Forrest Hills, Sterling Castle Heights, East Kirkland Heights and Burnside Valley.**
