WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **sections of St. Mary who are served by the Agualta Vale Nutsfield Relift Station** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to an electrical problem at the facility.

Areas affected by this disruption include:

Heywood Hall, Pinnacle, Lebanon Housing Scheme, Islington, Albany, Zion Hill, Sport Road, Rosend, Robins Bay, Baccaswood, White Hall, Nutsfield, Martin, Friendship, Lindon Housing Scheme.

In the meantime, customers in **Dolphin Bay, John Town, Spring Bank and Anchovy Land Settlement** who are served by the **Grants Level Treatment Plant in Portland** will experience low water pressure resulting from power fluctuations at the plant.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience caused and is making every effort to restore normal water supply to all the affected areas at the earliest possible time.
