Leak Disrupts Water Supply to St. Andrew Areas....JWSIP Works continue to affect Traffic & Water Supply in Stony Hill Areas

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in **Stony Hill, Golden Spring, Jack's Hill, Stillwell Road, Lawrence Tavern, Tavistock, Mannings Hill, Bridge Mount, Sunset Avenue, Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle** in St. Andrew that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to a leak on the distribution network of the Seaview Filter Plant

Repair work is currently in progress and every effort is being made to restore water supply by 5:00pm this evening.

In the meantime, works under the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)**, will continue in the Stony Hill area for the period February 7-11, 2011. Customers and commuters in specific sections of the community will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road/lane closures/restrictions between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00pm daily for the period.

February 7, 2011 – Boon Hall Drive

February 8, 2011 – Seaview Road

February 9, 2011 – Hermitage Road and Newton Drive

February 10, 2011 – Stony Hill main road

February 11, 2011 – Old Stony Hill Road and Fort Georges Road

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by this necessary improvement works and urges customers to store water for the periods of service disruption. Commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and flagmen that will be in place.
