Maintenance Works to Cause Water Supply Disruption to sections of St. Catherine & Clarendon

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that it will be carrying out maintenance works on the Longville Park Well in **Clarendon on Tuesday, February 8, 2011 between the hours of 5:00am and 5:00pm.**

Customers in **Longville Park Housing Scheme** who are served by this facility will therefore experience a disruption in their water supply during these hours resulting from the temporary shut down to facilitate the works.

Similarly customers in **sections of St. Catherine** who served are by the **Dinthill Well, Nutshell and Jericho Relift Stations** will experience no water conditions or low water pressure on **Tuesday, February 8, 2011 between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm** also due to maintenance works that will be carried out at these facilities.

Areas that will be affected include:

Dinthill, Linstead, Bog Walk, sections of Knollis, Deeside, Mickleton, Wakesfield, Jew Pen, Grove Road, Rosemount, sections of Church Road, Mickleton Meadows, Commodore, Buena Vista, White House, Banbury, Victoria, Orangefield, Jericho, Polly Ground, Charlemont Housing Scheme, Cotton Piece and Orange Village.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works and urges customers in the affected areas to store water for use during the periods of disruption.
