



WATER RESTRICTION TO AFFECT CORPORATE AREA WATER SUPPLY

.....Customers Urged to CONSERVE WATER

The National Water Commission is again urging its customers across the island to conserve on their use of water especially as rainfall in catchment areas continue to decrease. The **Hermitage Dam** which supplies water to several corporate area communities is of particular concern at this time and has called for an immediate revision of the current water distribution plan at the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant from 24 hours of supply to 16 hours daily.** This operation will begin on **Saturday, February 5, 2011** and customers will, depending on their elevation and location on the system, either have no piped water or have low water pressure at nights from **8 pm to 4 am.**
