**WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION – SECTIONS OF ST. THOMAS &
CLARENDON**

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **sections of Clarendon** who are served by the **Woodside Well** that **the system will be taken out of operation on Wednesday, February 9, 2011** to facilitate repairs to the pumping system. This will result in disruption in water supply to the following communities:

Woodside, Pleasant Valley, Race Track, Rose Hall, Pennant Wood, Jacobs Hut, Lower Denbigh, Foga Road, Midland Glades, Glenmuir Housing Scheme.

The system **will be reinstated on Friday, February 11, 2011**. Customers in the named communities are therefore being urged to store water for the period of disruption.

In the meantime, the NWC is also advising that it is experiencing mechanical challenges on the **Dumphries Water Supply System in St. Thomas**, customers served by this facility will therefore experience low water pressure.

Areas that are affected include:

**Dumphries
Morant Bay High School
High Berry and surrounding areas.**

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience caused and is making every effort to restore normal water supply to all the affected areas in the shortest possible time.
