### **Vandalism Causes Water Supply Disruption in Clarendon**

The National Water Commission is reporting that an 8” cast iron transmission pipeline that runs from the Chatteau Deepwell to Sevens in Clarendon has been vandalized resulting in a break on the line and subsequent shutting down of the system.

Customers who are normally supplied by this water supply system will therefore experience a disruption in their usual piped water service until the necessary repairs are carried out. Repairs are scheduled to begin tomorrow, Tuesday, February 15, 2011.

The NWC is noting that it will be supplying water to the affected areas by truck and hopes to complete repairs by Wednesday, February 16. Areas that are impacted include: **Sevens Estate Ltd, Sevens Road, Sevens Plantation, Effortville, Oliver Gardens, Warsop Farm, Zion Avenue, Leon Avenue, Donald Avenue, Atkinson Drive, Alexander Avenue, Mt. Clair, Bryants Crescent, Stewart Avenue, Sewell Crescent, Windsor Avenue, Fosmore Drive and May Pen.**

The National Water Commission apologizes to its customers for the interruption in their service and continues to appeal to the public to desist from acts of vandalism and theft of its infrastructure.
