**WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION...St. Andrew Areas Affected
...Update on St. Catherine Areas**

The National Water Commission is advising that it will be **reducing water supply from a section of the Constant Spring Treatment Plant for the next four hours**. This is to carry out urgent leak repairs to a major distribution pipeline that will cause low water pressure to a number of St. Andrew communities including: **Dunrobin Avenue and roads leading off, Constant Spring Road and all roads leading off, Sections of Half Way Tree Road and roads leading off and sections of the Cross Roads area.**

Normal water supply will be restored to these areas by 5:00pm today.

In the meantime, customers who are served by the **Sunnyside Well in St. Catherine** will continue to experience a disruption in their water supply due to ongoing mechanical works on the system. Areas affected by this disruption include: **Sunnyside Housing Scheme, New Works, Rose Hall and sections of Time and Patience**. Customers will therefore continue to be supplied by trucked water until the completion of works on **Wednesday, February 16, 2011**.

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience that may be caused to its valued customers and is working assiduously to ensure the timely restoration of water supply to the affected areas.
