**WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTING SECTIONS
OF ST. JAMES AND GREATER MANDEVILLE**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that it will be carrying out urgent leak repair work in Lima, located in St. James on Tuesday, February 15, 2011.

Customers in Adelphi, Dumfries, Goodwill, Chatham, Content, Somerton, Cargen and Paisley, who are served by the Canaan Deep Well, will therefore experience a disruption in their water supply.

Every effort will be made to complete the repairs by 05:00pm today.

At the same time, due to an electrical problem at the Gutters Pumping Station in St. Elizabeth, customers in Greater Mandeville will experience low water pressure and no water conditions.

The maintenance team is working feverishly to resolve the problem in the shortest possible time.
