WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST. CATHERINE

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in **sections of St. Catherine who are served by the Cocoa Ridge Relift Station and Gold Mine Treatment Plant** that the disruption they have been experiencing in their water supply is due to power supply problems at these facilities.

Areas affected include: **Bodose Hill, Bellas Gate, Cocoa Ridge, Joe Ground, Sand Hole, Content, Rhule Town, Sandy Ground, Bellefield, Marlie Hill, Joe Ground, Bamboo Ridge, Bartons, Wood Hall, Brown's Hall, Gravel Hill, Blue Hole and Macca Tree.**

The NWC is working with the Jamaica Public Service Company Ltd to resolve these matters at the earliest possible time.

In the meantime, the **Sue River Treatment Plant, also located in St. Catherine**, is out of operation due to high turbidity levels and blocked intakes. Customers will therefore experience interruptions in their usual piped water supply.

Areas affected by this disruption include: **Free Town, Bernard, Sue River, Mizpah, St. Faiths, Cassava River, Goffe Road, Jambos Pond, Centre Cut, Ennis, Accles Hill, Above Rocks, Zion Hill, Harkers Hall, Big Road, Retirement, Adward Piece, Barnett, St. Faiths, Mount Mattis and Glengoffe.** Regular water supply will be restored to these areas as soon as possible.

The National Water Commission apologizes to its customers for any inconvenience caused.
