**URGENT LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that the Cambridge Treatment Plant in St. James will be shut down on Thursday, February 17, 2011 at 02:00pm until Friday, February 18, 2011 at 06:00pm. This is necessary to facilitate urgent leak repair work.

Therefore, customers in **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge, Ducketts, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain and Lambs River** will experience a disruption in their water supply.
