WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTING GREATER MANDEVILLE

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers in Greater Mandeville, that due to an electrical problem at the Gutters Pumping Station in St. Elizabeth, they will experience low water pressure and no water conditions.

Affected areas include: Downs, Prospect, sections of New Forest, sections of New Green, Farm, Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, New Port, Ward Avenue, Hartease, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln and Huntley, Hibiscus Gardens, Fourteenth Street, Dunsenain, Philham Drive, Scott's Town, Caledonia Meadows, sections of Bonito Crescent, Perth, Waltham, Cedar Grove Housing Scheme, Havendale High, Northern Caribbean University, Hillside, Knock Patrick, Wales, Richmond, Woodland Housing Scheme, Woodland Road, Godfrey Land and Cedar Grove Estate.
