WATER RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

..... Customers Urged to Continue to Conserve

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in sections of Kingston and St. Andrew served by the Constant Spring/ Hermitage Water Supply System, that effective last weekend, nightly water restrictions were discontinued.

This most welcome relief during the normally dry period is as a result of improved water level at the Hermitage Dam due mainly to increased inflows from the recent heavy rains. But, even while the NWC has eased the restrictions, the company continues to monitor its operations so as to minimize the need to implement an early resumption.

Noting that monitoring is not a one-way activity, Corporate Public Relations Manager, Charles Buchanan urges customers to do their part by implementing strong conservation measures to mitigate any future drastic restrictions before the rainy season begins. "While conservation of water will mean careful use of the precious commodity and storage for periods of drought, customers are also reminded that conservation will also result in savings in their water bills",
