Electrical & Mechanical Problems Cause Water Supply Disruption

National Water Commission customers in **sections of St. Thomas** who are served by the **Springfield Well** are being advised that the facility is currently experiencing electrical problems which will cause low water pressure or no water conditions.

Areas affected include: **Morant Bay, Lyssons, Prospect, Retreat, Duhaney Pen, Rosselle, Stanton Road, Highbury, Seaforth, Alexander Park, Dumfries and surrounding areas.**

Every effort is being made to carry out the necessary repair work and restore normal water supply at the earliest possible time.

In the meantime, the **Wakefield Well located in St. Catherine** is also out of operation. This is due to severe mechanical problems which have resulted in disruption in water supply for customers served by the facility. Areas impacted by this downtime include: **Buxton Town, Backland, Savannah and Wakefield.**

The National Water Commission apologizes to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused and is working to ensure the timely completion of works on these facilities.
