### **JWSIP WORKS TO CAUSE FURTHER DISRUPTIONS IN STONY HILL AREAS**

The National Water Commission is reporting that the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project works in Stony Hill, St. Andrew will continue this week. The works will include excavations, pipeline repairs, valve replacement and asphalt works. Accordingly, customers and commuters in the area will experience disruptions in water supply as well as minor traffic delays due to lane/road restrictions or closures.

Areas that will be impacted include: **Lipscombe Drive where excavation works will be carried out on Monday, February 28. Valve replacement works will be done on Mannings Hill Road on Tuesday, March 1, while pipeline works will be carried out on Wednesday and Thursday on the Hermitage Road as well as on Brooks Level Road on Friday, March 4.**

**Road/Lane closures or restrictions will occur in these areas from 8:00am to 6:00pm daily for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should be expected in these areas between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm, except for Hermitage Road where the period of disruption will last for two days starting from Wednesday, March 2, at 9:00am to Thursday, March 3, 5:00pm.**

In addition, asphalt works will be carried out from Monday, February 28 to Thursday March 3, 2011 in the following areas: **Gibson Road, Montgomery Drive, Old Golden Spring Road, Stillwell Road, Mannings Hill Road, Sherbourne Heights, Airy Castle Road, Stony Hill Main Road, Golden Meadows, Brooks Level Road, Seaview Road and Old Stony Hill Road.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by this necessary improvement works and urges customers to store water for the periods of service disruption. Commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of flag personnel that will be in place.

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
