**Water Supply Disruption for Sections of St. Andrew
...Stony Hill, Jacks Hill, Castle James areas affected**

The National Water Commission is advising that it will be carrying out urgent improvement works at the **Seaview Filter Plant in St. Andrew for the next two weeks starting, today, February 28, 2011**. These works are being carried out as part of the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project and will result in disruptions in water supply to customers in the following areas:

Stony Hill, Golden Spring, Jack's Hill, Stillwell Road, Lawrence Tavern, Tavistock, Mannings Hill, Bridge Mount, Sunset Avenue, Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle. Customers in these areas are being urged to store water for use since they will experience low water pressure and no water conditions during the period of works.

In the meantime, customers served by the **Castle James Relift Station**, also located in St. Andrew, are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to a broken 6" main which has caused a temporary shutdown of operations.

Areas affected include: **Castle James, Parts of Cooper's Hill, Shoucair Circle, Swain Spring, Padmore, Sections of Sterling Castle, Cavaliers and Pinto**. Every effort is being made to complete the necessary repairs and restore operations at the soonest possible time.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary service interruptions.
