Mechanical Problems Cause Water Supply Disruption

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in **Down Town - Kingston, Spanish Town Road, Duhaney Park, Molynes Road, Washington Gardens & Boulevard and all roads leading off** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is as a result of mechanical problems associated with the **White Marl and Ferry systems** that serve these areas.

In addition, customers who are served by the **Forest Hill Deep Well** in St. Andrew are being advised that they will also experience no water conditions due to the shutdown of the facility for mechanical repairs. Areas impacted include: **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle, Sterling Castle Heights, East & West Kirkland Heights, Burnside Valley, Red Hills Square, and Forrest Hills.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers and is working assiduously to restore normal operations at these facilities within the shortest possible time.
