**Mechanical & Power Supply Problems affect water supply in Sections of St. Mary
...Scheduled Water Supply Disruption for St. Andrew areas**

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **sections of St. Mary** who are served by the **Iteboreale System** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their service is due to public power supply problems at the facility.

Areas impacted by this downtime include:

Highgate, Richmond, Esher, Lewis Store, Frazerwood, parts of Tremolesworth, Clonmel, Alleppo, Cromwelland, Stockholm Park Housing Scheme, Graham Heights, Harmony Hall, Belfield, Comsee, Orange River Housing Scheme, Capture Land, Bellfield, Clermont Pen, Bellfield Line, Bellfield Pen, Upper Esher, Heywood Hall, Pinnacle, Lebanon Housing Scheme, Islington, Albany, Zion Hill, Sport Road, Rosend, Robins Bay, Baccaswood, White Hall, Nutsfield, Martin, Friendship and Lindon Housing Scheme .

Additionally Customers in Castleton, Friendship Gap and Cleary Spring also in St. Mary are experiencing similar disruption due to mechanical challenges at the Castleton Pumping Station.

Every effort is being made to carry out the necessary remedial works to these systems in order to restore normal water supply to all the affected areas.

In the meantime, the NWC is also advising that it will be carrying out works on the **Camp Well in St. Andrew on Tuesday, March 8, 2010 between the hours of 10:00am and 2:00pm**. The Up Park Camp area and sections of Vineyard Town will experience a disruption in their water supply for the period of the works and are therefore being urged to store water for use.
