### **Project Works Continue to Affect Traffic & Water Supply in Stony Hill Areas**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works will continue in the Stony Hill area of St. Andrew for the week March 7-11, 2011. Consequently, **customers and commuters in the area will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road closure/restrictions for the period. Areas that will be affected include:**

**Orange View Drive, Old Stony Hill Road – Monday, March 7, 2011.**

**Mannings Hill Road – Tuesday, March 8, 2011.**

**Hermitage Road – Thursday, March 10, 2011.**

**Golden Way, Brook Level Road – Friday, March 11, 2011.**

**Water supply interruptions should be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily except for the Hermitage Road area where the disruption will last for two days. Where lane restrictions/closures are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by this necessary improvement works and urges customers to store water for the periods of service disruption. Commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and flagmen that will be in place.
