Emergency Works Cause Water Supply Disruption

The National Water Commission is reporting that **Havenmeade Relift Station in St. Andrew** has been shut down to carry out emergency repairs to the system. This has resulted in water supply disruption in a number of communities including:

Kingswood, Ursa Major, Belgrade Heights, West Meade, Sherbourne Heights, Smokey Vale, Diamond Road, Wireless Station Road and Mount Salus. Repairs to the system are expected to be complete tomorrow, March 11 at 5:00pm.

In the meantime, customers in **sections of St. Mary** who are served by the **Agualta Vale water supply system will experience an interruption in their service tomorrow March 11, between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.** This disruption in service is to facilitate urgent pipeline repairs.

Areas that will be impacted include:

Highgate, Richmond, Esher, Lewis Store, Frazerwood, parts of Tremolesworth, Clonmel, Aleppo, Cromwelland, Stockholm Park Housing Scheme, Graham Heights, Harmony Hall, Belfield, Comsee, Orange River Housing Scheme, Capture Land, Bellfield, Clermont Pen, Bellfield Line, Bellfield Pen, Upper Esher, Heywood Hall, Pinnacle, Lebanon Housing Scheme, Islington, Albany, Zion Hill, Sport Road, Rosend, Robins Bay, Baccaswood, White Hall, Nutsfield, Martin, Friendship, Lindon Housing Scheme.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works and will endeavour to restore regular water supply to all the affected in the times specified.
