Pipeline Works to Interrupt Corporate Area Water Supply

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that it will be carrying out pipeline works at a number of its corporate area facilities for the period **March 15 to March 18, 2011**. These works will result in brief **water supply disruption between the hours of 10:00am and 2:00pm** for the period. The facilities and specific areas that will be affected include:

The **Forrest Hill Deep Well on Tuesday, March 15**, which will impact customers in **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle, Forrest Hills, Sterling Castle Heights, East Kirkland Heights, Burnside Valley, Red Hills Square and Belvedere;**

The **Chancery Hall Well on Wednesday, March 16** which will affect water supply to **Havendale, Meadowbrook, sections of Queensborough, Lady Hamilton Drive, Van Guard, sections of Michigan Avenue and upper sections of Molyne's Road;** and on **Friday, March 18, the Montgomery Corner Well** which supplies **Trench Town, Arnett Gardens, Maxfield Avenue, and Lower Marescaux Road.**

Customers who will be affected are being urged to store water for use during the period of interruption.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
