**SCHEDULED WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION...
...ST. ANDREW & CLARENDON AREAS TO BE AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works will continue in the **Stony Hill** area of **St. Andrew** for the week March 21-25, 2011. Consequently, **customers and commuters in the area will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road closure/restrictions for the period. Areas that will be affected include:**

Fort Georges Crescent on Tuesday, March 22 to Wednesday, March 23.

Montgomery Road on Thursday, March 24 to Friday March 25.

Where lane restrictions/closures are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should also be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily, except in the case of Montgomery where the disruption will last for two days from Thursday March 24 until Friday, March 25, 2011.

Excavation and asphalt works will also be carried out in Montgomery Terrace, Gibson Road, Old Stony Hill Road, Hermitage Road, Mannings Hill Road, Brooks Level Road, Seaview Road and Orange View Drive from Monday, March 21 through to April 2, 2011.

Customers in the mentioned areas are urged to store water for the periods of service disruption and commuters are encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of the flag personnel on location.

In the meantime, customers in **sections of Clarendon** who are served by the **New Town Well** will experience similar disruptions in their water supply on **Monday, March 21 through to Wednesday, March 23**. This interruption in service is to facilitate maintenance works that will be carried out on the system. Areas that will be affected include: **New Town Phase 1 & 2, Raymonds and Monymusk Housing Scheme**. Customers in these communities are also urged to store water for the period of disruption.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
