**Pipeline & Maintenance Works to Interrupt Corporate Area Water Supply  
...Water Supply Disruption in St. Thomas**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that it will be carrying out pipeline and maintenance works at a number of its corporate area facilities for the period **March 22 to March 24, 2011**. These works will result in brief **water supply disruption between the hours of 10:00am and 4:00pm** for the period. The facilities and specific areas that will be affected include:

The **Hope Filter Plant** which will impact customers in **Papine, Elleston Flats, Gordon Town Road, Gordon Town, and Kintyre** on **Tuesday, March, 22**.

The **Stillwell Road pipeline on Wednesday, March 23, which will affect water supply to Stillwell Road; and on Thursday, March 24 the White Marl system** which supplies water to sections of **Down Town Kingston, Spanish Town Road and roads leading off, Duhaney Park, Washington Gardens, Washington Boulevard and roads leading off, Molyne's Road and roads leading off**.

Customers in the mentioned areas are being urged to store water for use during the period of interruption.

In the meantime, customers in **Arcadia, Guinep Lane, and Long Hill** in **St. Thomas** who are served by the **Arcadia Relift Station** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to mechanical challenges on the system. Every effort is being made to carry out the necessary repair work and restore water supply to these areas within the shortest possible time.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
