**Water Supply Disruption... Sections of St. Catherine Affected  
...Scheduled Works to Disrupt Water Supply in St. Andrew Areas**

The National Water Commission is advising customers in sections of St. Catherine who are served by the Sligoville water supply system that the disruption they have been experiencing in their service is due to mechanical challenges on the system.

Areas affected by this disruption include: **Top and Bottom Kensington, Sligoville, James Mountain, Cedar Valley, Stanbury Grove, Pleasant Hill, St. Mary's Village, Binn's Close and Top and Bottom Jackson.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused and will continue to provide trucked water to these areas. The company is also advising that every effort is being made to resolve the problem so normal water supply can be restored.

In the meantime, customers in **St. Andrew** who are served by the **Forrest Hill Pumping Station** will experience a disruption in their water supply on **Thursday, March 24, 2011** between the hours of 8:00am to 5:30. This disruption is to facilitate mechanical works that will be carried out on the system.

Customers in **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle, Forrest Hills, Brentwood, Sterling Castle Heights, East Kirkland Heights, Burnside Valley, and Red Hills Square** who are supplied by this system are being encouraged to store water for use during the period of disruption.
